

# Chant Legacy Scholarship

for postgraduate study in governance



**The Chant Legacy Scholarship has been made possible by a trust set up in the original will of the late Mr Leonard Watson Chant. Its purpose is to provide funds to students seeking to undertake postgraduate study in the area of governance.**

As the trustee of the Chant Legacy Scholarship, Governance Institute of Australia (Governance Institute) is pleased to offer an opportunity for individuals who have a need and a desire to study governance at a postgraduate level.

Practical skills and applied knowledge in governance have never been more valued by organisations and government departments worldwide and for many it provides the opportunity to pursue a career as a senior governance professional, senior manager and take on board directorships.

## Postgraduate governance scholarship — award benefit

Successful applicants are entitled to an amount up to \$2,290 per subject and up to \$4,580 per semester (where more than one subject is studied within the semester) and to a maximum of \$9,160 per year. The total amount awarded for any applicant is to a maximum of \$13,740 for the whole course of study (pending CPI increase).

The scholarship funding covers study fees only. It will not cover any other fees or expenses incurred such as travel, campus accommodation, suggested reading and study materials.

## Eligibility for submissions for the scholarship

- In order to be eligible, you need to show that you meet the requirements of entry into the nominated postgraduate governance course in accordance with the rules of the relevant government accredited education provider.
- Your course of study needs to be relevant to your governance career aspirations.
- You must show a financial need in order to apply for the scholarship.
- If your chosen program of study is already under way you will not be eligible for the scholarship.

Please note: Those that receive entry into the scholarship are only eligible to complete the number of subjects approved by the scholarship award committee and not extra subjects as and when requested by the applicant.

## Submission requirements

All scholarship applicants must provide:

- a completed application form (overleaf)
- certified copies of **two different official forms** of personal identification (for example, photo page of passport, driver's licence, birth certificate)
- demonstrate that you meet the requirements of entry into the nominated postgraduate governance course
- a brief statement on why you intend to study a postgraduate governance course, and the reasons you feel entitled to receive a scholarship award.

Applications close on Friday, 11 October 2019 for study to be undertaken in Semester 1, 2020. Scholarship applications will be judged and awarded by an independent committee with successful recipients being informed in December for study the following year.
